



Spring 2014 Project Prioritization Results

The ITS Project Prioritization cycle for Spring 2014 has been completed and the results communicated to the proposers. The Steering Committee received a total of 10 project proposals, of which eight were recommended to, and approved by, the Vice Presidents. Each proposal was reviewed and scored using the rubric developed specifically for this purpose, and staff resource requirements assessed by ITS, in order to determine the final selection.
