Fall applications are accepted beginning October 1; spring applications beginning August 1. Applications are online at www.csumentor.edu.

In addition to a CSU graduate application and all college transcripts (official), applicants are required to submit the materials listed below to complete their application. Please check with the individual departments for any additional requirements that may not appear below.

BIOLOGY: Three letters of recommendation. Statement of objectives. GRE - verbal, quantitative and analytical sections required.

BUSINESS: GMAT or GRE required; scoring of at least 500 on the GMAT or scoring a combined total of at least 1,000 on the verbal and quantitative components of the GRE exam. GPA of 2.75.

EDUCATION: Three letters of recommendation from persons who can assess your potential for graduate work.

* Applications received prior to February 15 will receive full consideration. Applications received after this date will be considered dependent on space available

ENGLISH: Three letters of recommendation (Humboldt students using HSU English faculty as references need only supply the names). GRE. Statement of objectives.

ENVIRONMENT & COMMUNITY (Social Science): Three letters of recommendation. Letter of application indicating reasons for interest in program. A 10-page writing sample.

ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS: Three letters of recommendation. Statement of plans and objectives. Some programs require a GRE, please contact the coordinator.

* Applications received prior to February 15 will receive full consideration. Applications received after this date will be considered dependent on space available.

KINESIOLOGY: GRE. Three references, including contact information. Statement of intent.

NATURAL RESOURCES: Three letters of recommendation and a resume. Statement of plans and objectives. GRE required for all options.

PSYCHOLOGY: Contact the Psychology Department for specific program requirements and application materials.

* Applications received prior to January 15 will receive full consideration. Applications received after this date will be considered dependent on space available.

SOCIAL WORK: Complete department application packet, includes personal statement, summary of experience, and three letters of recommendation. Go to www.humboldt.edu/socialwork/degrees/msw/admissions.html for the application packet.

* Review of applications begins February 15, final date to post applications is January 31. Applications received prior to January 31, will receive full consideration. Applications received after this date will be considered dependent on space available.

SOCIOLOGY: Three letters of recommendation. Statement of plans and objectives. The GRE is not required for application into our program.
