Wireless Procedures: Callahan reviewed the draft wireless procedures (handout). A brief discussion ensued and the document was submitted for the 30-day review period.

The idea is to have account administrators at multiple locations throughout the campus including the Help Desk, Residence Halls, Room Reservations, Parking, and the Library. The guest account administrators would require a picture ID before creating a guest account. McBrearty noted that the University does not have a legal obligation to provide computing resources to the general public. Conference accounts will be handled in a slightly different manner. Callahan provided a document showing how guest access will work.
