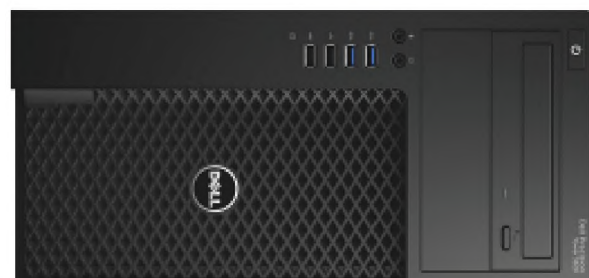
Projector

- 1) Lower screen using the Screen switch. Lower the window shades if necessary.
- 2) Press the **On** button on the control panel
- 3) Press button for desired device – Computer, Laptop, HDMI, Document Camera



Using Console Computer

- 1) Set switch to Computer
- 2) Press **Power** button (in the upper right corner)
- 3) Follow login instructions for:
Windows
 - a. Control - Option - Delete
 - b. Click OK
 - c. Enter user name and password
 - d. Click Enter



Using a Laptop

- 1) Turn on your laptop
- 2) Press Laptop button on control panel
- 3) Connect the **HDMI cable** to the video output port on your laptop.
- 4) Connect your laptop's AC adaptor to a power outlet and start up your laptop.
- 5) If you still do not see an image, refer to the **laptop troubleshooting guide** later in these instructions.
- 6) When finished, shut down your laptop and disconnect all cables.
- 7) Proceed to shutting down the rest of the equipment. Follow the instructions later in this guide, **Powering Down the System**.



Sound

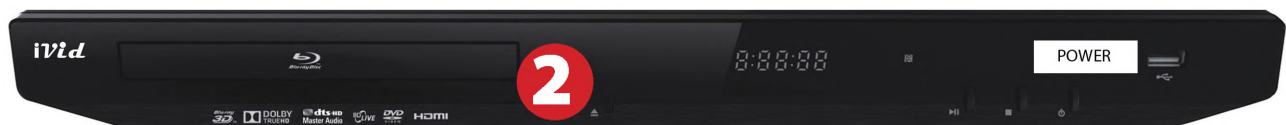
White Control Panel

- 1) Adjust volume on white control panel.



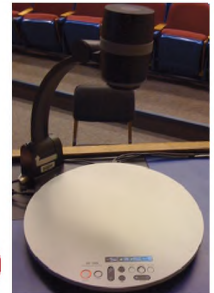
Playing a DVD/Blu-Ray

- 1) Press **DVD** on the white control panel.
- 2) Insert media into the DVD/Blu-Ray player
- 3) Use the white control panel to control the player.



Using the Document Camera

- 1) Set display switch box to **Doc Camera**.
- 2) Power on the **Document Camera**. The computer does not need to be turned on to use the document camera.
- 3) Press the **Live/Win** button to switch between showing the Windows desktop and showing the camera image full-screen.



Using an HDMI Device

An HDMI cable is provided for connecting devices such as some laptops, iPads/iPhones and Android devices.

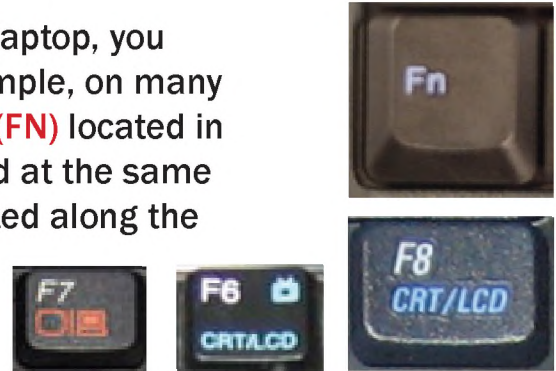
- 1) Set display switch box to **HDMI**
- 2) Connect your device to the HDMI cable.



Please note: Certain devices, such as iPhones and iPads, will require an HDMI adaptor. Consult your owner's manual for further information.

Laptop Troubleshooting

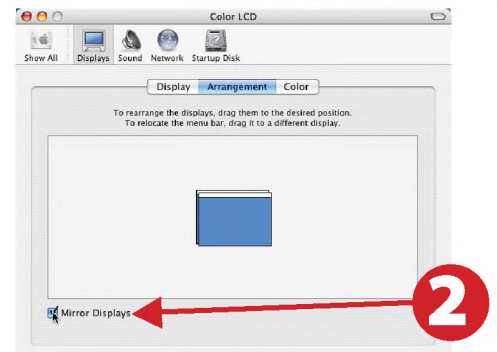
For PC Laptops: Depending on your model of laptop, you may need to toggle the display mode. For example, on many laptops, you must hold down the **function key (FN)** located in the lower left-hand corner of the keyboard, and at the same time, press the **video toggle key**, which is located along the top of the keyboard. Look for the text **CRT/LCD** or an icon of a **display and a laptop**.



Examples of video toggle keys

For Mac Laptops:

- 1) Go to **System Preferences/Display**.
- 2) Select the **Arrangement** tab and check the **Mirror Displays** box.



Powering Down the System

- 1) Press the Off button on the control panel to shut down the projector
- 2) Power down Computer

Windows

Start Menu -> Shut Down -> Click OK

- 3) Lower screen using the Screen switch
