Steering Committee:

As you will recall, when discussions about creating a campus portal began last year, we selected June 1 as the go-live date so that our newest students could start their HSU experience using this new tool. However, after analyzing our communication plan for newly-admitted students and considering the changes we have made in the summer HOP/HOOP process, I have decided to push the go-live date to July 2, 2012. We will introduce myHumboldt to all new and returning students in July, and have our major rollout at the on-campus HOP in August 2012.

This new schedule includes all single sign-on functionality. While the additional time may be used for more testing, please know that the significant efforts of the functional and technical teams will continue at pace. Most importantly, this extension does not open the door for changes to the scope of Evolution I.

I sincerely appreciate all of the hard work that has gone into the portal development thus far from the technical and functional teams, and I am very eager to introduce our students to myHumboldt in July! Please let me know if you have questions.
